#### A Tale of Woe – 1 Significant events which have adversely impacted upon Australia's prosperity, society and security:

- 1) **Property.** The erosion of property rights and the rise of socialism. This creeping socialism actually started in the mid 1850's and continues to the present day.
- 2) **Manufacturing.** The gradual erosion of Australia's manufacturing capability..
- 3) Maritime. The virtual extinction of Australia's maritime industry.
- 4) Fuel & Energy. The inability of Australia to acquire and refine liquid fuels necessary for aviation, shipping and ground transportation plus destruction of the electricity grid and the spurning of nuclear energy.

Since as early as the 1850's to the present day, Australia has been on a downward trajectory which is now reaching the point where its impact is threatening the property rights, health and general well-being of every Australian.

I will give you some examples of what I mean by this in the following slides.

### A Tale of Woe - 2

- **5) CCP.** The development of trading ties with Communist China to the extent that Australia's sovereignty can be threatened by trade embargoes applied from time to time when the Australian Government does or says something that upsets the Communists.
- 6) Aboriginal Industry. The conception of Native Title, weakening normal property rights and an assault on National pride and unity.
- 7) Education. A failing State run education system that is bent on indoctrination rather than education.
- 8) Unionisation. Large-scale unionisation of the public service such that the Labor Party is permanently embedded in the Executive Arm of Government.
- **9)** Separation of Powers. A diminution of the role of the Monarch such that there is really no clear separation between the Executive and the Legislature.
- **10) Public Debt.** The Global Financial Crisis in 2007 which needlessly put Australia \$300 billion in debt ending with over a trillion after COVID.

Without doubt, the greatest threat to world freedom and the liberty of every Australian comes from the rise of Communist China.

Additionally, the Aboriginal Industry continues to eat into the property rights, especially of farmers but it is also costing Australians over \$100 million a day due to the utter incompetence of Governments of all political persuasions.

- Education in this country is failing, the system producing graduates that fail to appreciate the dangers of socialism and totalitarian Government.
- Of all of the problems listed, the worst would be public debt which now stands at over \$1 trillion.

### A Tale of Woe - 3


- 11) **Compulsory Superannuation.** The introduction of compulsory superannuation, largely managed by unions making millions of dollars from "management fees" with a significant portion of that being channelled to the Labor Party.
- 12) **Destructive Industrial Laws.** Minimum wage, unfair dismissal, long service leave, leave loading and workers' compensation; making it very difficult and even hazardous for a small business owner to profitably run their business.
- 13) **Meaning of Marriage.** The erosion of the sanctity of marriage, including no-fault divorce and legitimising same sex marriage.
- 14) **Gender Dysphoria.** Draconian laws regarding "misgendering" and parent's rights.


- This decline is largely driven by Labor and the Greens but the incompetence of the LNP has also contributed to Australia's present parlous state.
- Compulsory superannuation provides huge funding to the Labor Party.
- Industrial laws make it ever harder for a person to start and run a small business.
- The changes made to marriage and social mores has added to divorce and confusion over the central tenet for marriage, namely procreation and the raising of young children to become productive members of society.

### A Tale of Woe – 4 (The Scam!) "Climate Change" A.K.A. Global Warming


Data taken from "long term" weather stations As @March 2021 BoM Map indicates there are 2,641 stations



- The cult of "Climate Change" threatens the ability of Australia to have the cheapest energy possible.
- Electricity costs around 7 cents per kWh in China. In Australia it costs the consumer around 40 cents. There is no way Australia's energy-intensive industries can compete internationally owing to this stupidity.
- At the core of this is the belief that human emissions of Carbon Dioxide is causing warming of the atmosphere and therefore must be stopped.
- So let's see if that is indeed the case. Here you see a graph from 1880 to the present day showing the maximum temperatures recorded at the red dots on the map are actually decreasing in Australia.




Some might say that the Australian temperature record is inaccurate or an anomaly. Here is a plot from the USA showing that from the early 20<sup>th</sup> century to the present day the temperatures have been dropping. The temperature measuring stations are shown by the red dots on this map.




Here is a plot showing the temperature record for Durban South Africa from 1885 to 1995.


The trend is downwards.



Likewise, data from Sierra Leone on the West coast of Africa from 1885 to 1995 shows the same downward trend.




Of considerable significance is this temperature plot from the Japanese Meteorological Agency for its Antarctic station. From 1960 to 2020, it shows a steady downward trend. Of interest, in 2023, this station measured the coldest temperature ever in Antarctica.



- Here is a plot from Brazil from 1896 to 2009. The temperature trend is downwards.
- These downwards trends were measured by independent agencies over more than 100 years. It is possible the magnitude of the reading could have been inaccurate but provided the same equipment and measuring procedures were being used, the trend would be an accurate representation.
- The chances of all of these trends being downwards and the downward trend being wrong is zero.

# Data from Greenland Ice-cores





Topping this off, this graph shows data extracted from two ice cores in Greenland that show over the last 8,000 years the earths atmospheric temperature has been dropping whilst, at the same time, the concentration of Carbon Dioxide in the earth's atmosphere has been steadily rising.

- As someone who has studied Thermodynamics to 4<sup>th</sup> year university level with honours, I assure you there is no way within the laws of Thermodynamics and atmospheric physics that Carbon Dioxide, nor Methane and Nitrous Oxide can **appreciably** warm the earth's atmosphere.
- In this opinion I am in good company. Professors Einstein, Angstrom, Lindzen, Happer, Plimer, Clauser, Soon.. and so the list goes on

### A Tale of Woe – 4 (The Cost) "Climate Change" A.K.A. Global Warming






There is a cost of **\$14 billion per year** incurred by consumers and taxpayers, or a total cost of **\$140 billion over 10 years**.

Already 10 coal fired baseload power stations have closed in Australia.


With \$140 billion, the Australian Taxpayer could have built **70 coal fired power stations**!

Here is what the result of this madness is.



- In recent times, Australians have witnessed the most incredible incompetence on the part of Government and been subjected to extreme physical and financial abuse.
- An emergency was declared and certain sections of the Commonwealth's Constitution were waived.
- Early treatment for COVID-19 was banned.
- Dangerous, improperly tested injections were forced onto the general population.
- Doctors have been deregistered for speaking out.
- All for a disease which, as this graph shows, did not warrant these extreme actions.



- As a part of this criminal scam, there was great exaggeration of the lethality of COVID-19. The blue graph shows the initial claims made by certain authorities in Sweden regarding who was dying of COVID-19. 5,813 deaths.
- A postmortem examination of death certificates showed of these 5,813 deaths, most likely only 872 died directly as a result of being infected with COVID-19. The rest died with that disease being present but, in actuality, these patients died of other causes.
- There was a 7 fold exaggeration and this was typical around the world.

### Who was driving this? The Fear-mongering!



This video was produced by the Chinese Communist Party and published around the world.


Its intent was to create panic.

- You will see that it is contrived. When the person in the film is about to hit the pavement, they put out their hands to break the fall.
- People falling unconscious to the pavement do not have the presence of mind to so skillfully break their fall!




Masks were enforced, once again to create panic.

- This is one of many graphs that show, if anything, masks actually can increase the spread of an RNA respiratory disease.
- This is most likely because, common with most Corona viruses, COVID-19 is largely spread through contagion.




- This graph shows that the more mRNA injections one receives the greater is the chance of contracting COVID-19 and dying.
- The so-called vaccines did not reduce deaths and definitely do not reduce the severity of the disease.
- Indeed, all data shows they have exactly the opposite effect.



Not only are these injections ineffective, all countries where these injections were employed now have an excess mortality rate running at around 15%.

It is a simple matter to find out the cause.

- The population that has been injected is dying at an above average rate whilst the population that was not injected is dying at the average rate of between 2015 and 2020.
- As they say, "It is no rocket science!" The injections have killed large numbers of Australians and permanently injured many, many more.



Since 2007 to the present day, Australia has managed to put itself over one trillion in debt.

- This amounts to a staggering \$59 billion every year for the past 17 years.
- With this expenditure, there is very little of enduring value to show for it.
- I believe this is deliberate. Every Western economy, especially the US is very heavily in debt to the extent that, one day, the system must collapse.

### The Root Causes?

- 1) Poor quality of political candidates &
- 2) Low quality of (compulsory) vote, leading to
- 3) Poor quality of politician compounded by
- 4) Deficiencies in the Westminster System of Government

The question one must ask is how did Australia get itself into such a mess?

The answer is shown in this slide.

Australia's present predicament is the product of: Poor quality political candidates which, when combined with the poor quality of vote, leads to a poor quality of politician who then can do great damage because of Deficiencies in the Westminster System of Government.

## My Dilemma

- These four things are interconnected.
- It is difficult to have a separate discussion on each because of this intrinsic inter-relationship.
- Perhaps the best thing in this short time is to look at the last item first

In presenting this subject to you I am faced some difficulties in that each of the issues I mentioned in the previous slide are inextricably intertwined. It is difficult to address each completely separately but it is most probably best that I deal with the deficiencies of the present system of Government first.

### Westminster System of Government Deficiencies

Let's start, then, with point "4".

- **4) Deficiencies in the Westminster System of Government** I'll save the influences of:
- \* poor quality of candidate,
- \* low quality of vote leading to
- poor quality of parliamentarian
  for a later speech.

I'll start them with Deficiencies in the Westminster System of Government

These present deficiencies give too much power to politicians and allow undue influence of partisan interests that do not have foremost in their minds the greater good of the Australian people.

These deficiencies, in the long term, actually threaten Australia's National Security and its very survival.

### A Sobering Reality

Something to always remember:-

**No democracy has ever survived** the test of time from the Ancient Greeks to the present day.

It is sobering to appreciate that no democracy has ever stood the test of time. All eventually fail.

### All Governments start with Good Intentions

Over time they become more and more

controlling.

Besides the fact that past democracies have not been enduring, it is also important to note that all Governments become more and more controlling of the citizens they are supposed to serve.

### **Always remember!**

History teaches us that Politicians can never be trusted.




In a similar vein to the fact that Governments become more and more controlling, one has to appreciate that politicians can never be trusted.

History teaches us that a significant number of politicians become involved in politics for the purpose of enriching themselves or because it pleases them to exert power and influence over others.

### The Main Reason why Democracies Fail?

Democracy typically descends into mob-rule.

TWO WOLVES AND A SHEEP VOTING ON WHAT'S FOR DINNER

Democracy has been described as two wolves and a lamb voting on what should be had for dinner.

The failure of democracy is that it inevitably descends into mob rule and with that totalitarianism leading to death and despair on a wide scale.

### All enduring Democracies have certain Inviolable Rules defined in a Constitution

Here are some of them:

- Right to speak freely
- Right to own property and keep it
- Right to earn an honest living
- Right to be treated equally
- All laws must be based on valid reasoning
- Right to defend oneself from assault and robbery
- Right to trial by jury of peers

To place guard rails on a democracy so that mob-rule will not prevail, all (so-far) successful democracies have a Constitution that guarantees certain rights to the citizens and limits the power of their Government.

Here are some of them.

# Role of a Constitution to Limit the Power of Government

"The two enemies of the people are criminals and Government. So let us tie down the second with the shackles of a Constitution so that it will not become a legalised version of the first."

#### Thomas Jefferson.

Thomas Jefferson put this nicely when he said something to the effect that:

- "The two enemies of the people are criminals and Government.
- So let us tie down the second with the shackles of a Constitution so that it will not become the legalised version of the first."

### **Tenor of a Constitution**

Because Government and the politicians that comprise it can never be trusted, the Constitution must take the form or a Master/Servant contract, where:

- the Government is the Servant, and
- the people are the Master

ALL CONSTITUTIONS, AT ALL LEVELS WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA FAIL ABYSMALLY IN THIS REGARD.

- The Constitution's preamble should not be filled with warm and fluffy words. It should state explicitly that this document is a master/servant contract where the people are the master and the Government is the servant.
- At the moment all Constitutions at the Federal, State and Territory levels of Government in Australia fail abysmally in this regard!

### The Golden Rule Pertaining to a Constitution

A Constitution must only be changed by the people because politicians can never be trusted.

# POLITICIANS SHOULD HAVE NO SAY IN THIS MATTER WHATSOEVER

- Being a master/servant contract, the Constitution must only be changed by the people and the mechanism for this is Referenda.
- Politicians should have no say in whether a Referendum shall be held, nor should they be allowed to decide the questions put and the manner in which the Referendum is conducted.
- The same rule has to apply to elections. Politicians should have no say in when an election is held nor how that election should be conducted.
- These matters have to be decided by an independent body elected by the people.

### **Referenda in Australia**

Section 128 of the Constitution presently provides for the 'mode of altering the Constitution'. Specifically, it requires:

- A law be passed by an absolute majority of each House of the Parliament (that is, half or more of all the members of each chamber), or under certain conditions, a law be passed by a majority of either House twice within three months.
- The proposal be put to the electors qualified to vote in elections for the House of Representatives between two and six months after the passage of the law.
- A majority of Australians vote to approve the change, as a total and in a majority of the six states (this is referred to as the 'double majority').

IN AUSTRALIA, REFERENDA WILL ONLY OCCUR WITH THE CONSENT OF THE POLITICIANS! AND, BEING UNTRUSTWORTHY, THEY WILL NOT CONSENT TO ANYTHING THAT WOULD DISADVANTAGE THEM OR THEIR POWER-BASE.

This is an extract from the present Commonwealth Constitution regarding how the Constitution may be changed.

It requires that politicians pass a bill in Parliament.

- This places too much power and trust in the Government of the day. It is possible that a rogue Government would never allow a Referendum to address a deficiency in the Constitution when that deficiency favours that Government.
- Governments will always construct the question to be posed so that it has the greatest chance of being approved.

### **The Constitutions of States**

- Largely based off the New South Wales Constitution Act passed in the British Parliament 16 July 1855
- Written by Governors Gipps and FitzRoy with the advice of William Wentworth and John Macarthur.

- It is important to note that the Constitutions of the State Government were all based on the 1855 Constitution of New South Wales Act passed by the British Parliament in 1855.
- This Constitution was the product of autocratic Governors and influential wealthy elites in the colony. There was no consideration given in that Constitution to the rights of the citizens.

# **Changing State Constitutions**

State Constitutions can be changed by politicians.

#### Example, NSW: Recognition of Aboriginal people

(1) Parliament, on behalf of the people of New South Wales, acknowledges and honours the Aboriginal people as the State's first people and nations.

(2) Parliament, on behalf of the people of New South Wales, recognises that Aboriginal people, as the traditional custodians and occupants of the land in New South Wales—

(a) have a spiritual, social, cultural and economic relationship with their traditional lands and waters, and

(b) have made and continue to make a unique and lasting contribution to the identity of the State.

(3) Nothing in this section creates any legal right or liability, or gives rise to or affects any civil cause of action or right to review an administrative action, or affects the interpretation of any Act or law in force in New South Wales.

Most importantly, certain parts of the Constitution of any State may be changed by the Legislature, not by a Referendum of the people.

Even when the people, through a referendum vote against something, the Government can still go ahead and do it. An example fo this was that the upper house in Qld was dissolved by an act of Parliament in 1922 despite the fact that, in 1917, the people of Qld voted that it should be retained.

Here you see a change that was made to the NSW Constitution without the consent of the people of NSW.

When you read this you see that it is dangerous, untruthful and completely disingenuous.

### Limiting the Power of Politicians

- Change Constitution only by Referenda initiated by the citizens, these to be binding.
- Elections, their manner and timing should only be decided by a citizens' elected body.
- No emergency without referral to the people by way of a plebiscite.
- No waiver of Constitution without permission of the people by way of a plebiscite.
- Strict (shortest) time-limit on any waiver.
- No treaties without the permission of people by way of a plebiscite.
- No sale or destruction of public assets without permission of the people by way of a plebiscite
- Major Policies to be put to the people by plebiscite (eg Nuclear & Immigration)
- Public Debt Limit to be a percentage of GDP, no waiver without an approving plebiscite
- Voting Age to be decided by the people by way of a plebiscite

The Constitution of the Commonwealth of Australia has a list of the powers the Federal Government may exercise. These are called, "enumerated powers".

There are very few mentions in that Constitution that explicitly limit the power of the Government over the citizens.

Here is a short list of limits that should be imposed on Government by way of a Constitution.

## In Conclusion

- Australia has been on a bad trajectory since the mid-1850's
- This is because of the poor quality of Australia's elected representatives and systemic problems with the Government of this Country.

### THESE THINGS WE CAN REMEDY!

- At the beginning of this presentation I gave you a short list of things that have gone and are going very badly wrong in this country.
- If this continues there is a good chance this country will change to the point where it will be unrecognisable to its present citizens.
- This decline can be traced back to the poor quality of politicians and systemic weaknesses in our system of democracy and Government.
- Chief amongst the latter is the poor quality of Australia's Constitutions at all levels of Government. As a first step this deficiency must be addressed with some urgency.
