The motion which passed at Glasshouse Country Liberal National Party branch on Thu 2.10.2025, and in early 2026 this motion was passed at the Liberal-National Party Regional Council meeting on the Sunshine Coast, was:

Bungalows and Spare Rooms as Hobby Income

The rent from a rented bungalow or a spare room in a home being a principal place of residence, shall be considered as a hobby income not subject to income tax, so that the home, while not claiming tax deductions, would certainly not be subject to extra local council taxes nor establishment fees, nor future capital gains taxes nor land taxes.

(The actual motion passed at Regional LNP meeting on Saturday 1.11.2025 was worded a bit differently, more reflecting changes needed at a Federal level in Australia. Gerry.)

From 1920's to 1980's home owners would often rent a room or build a bungalow for extended family, or to provide some income which also provided accommodation often to low wage earners or welfare recipients, and often just to provide an enlarged home as post war building restrictions kept many then new homes to just two bedrooms. These small private solutions helped to provide 'a roof' in keeping with Menzies Liberal philosophy.

Then came Labor Paul Keating anti-private-solutions concepts which included capital gains tax eventually extending to a person's principal place of residence if any income was derived from any letting, and income tax. Then land taxes, especially in Victoria if a room was rented.

So, bungalows decreased, and rooms stopped being available. And we have the biggest crisis in our history of people unable to find accommodation, of mothers caring for children in a car, of people even in jobs not being able to find a room.

For example: bungalow with 4.84 sqm bedroom 4.84 sqm living kitchen area (2.2x2.2m) with 2.52 sq m shower-room-toilet-basin-washing-machine, 2.8 sqm of hall, so 15.664 sqm total inside or 2.2 m x 7.12 m for two-Golden-Ratio.

In Melbourne, they own a home which they bought for about \$600,000 two decades ago and is now worth about \$1,800,000. They might move in the next two years but need to sell and buy on the same market. As this is their principal place of residence they would not need to pay capital gains tax if they do make the move.

James has a friend from school days, Christopher, to whom they would have liked to rent a room, maybe \$100 a week, rather than Chris living on the street. If they did rent this room, their home, in two years time if they sell, would possibly be up for \$1,800,000 less \$600,000 for \$1,200,000 rise by 30% which is \$360,000 capital gains tax; then, in Vic Labor govt plus some \$36,000 a year land tax. So, the room is not rented & Chris lives on the street. Of course Jim Chambers would also like to charge "imputed" capital gains so that each year with about 10% value rise of the house of \$60,000, about \$20,000 would be paid on the 'nominal' gain of value of the home. This is not really a value gain, as selling and buying on the same market provides very little real incomes.

This motion does not reduce government revenue as very few such rooms are currently rented!! Better to have a Keating clock collection?
